

Dear Scholarship Applicant:

Thank you for contacting Delegate Kirill Reznik regarding his Delegate Scholarship. In order to apply, you must be a resident of Maryland's 39th Legislative District.

To be considered for a scholarship, you must include **ALL** of the following:

- The attached scholarship application
- Unofficial transcript from the school you currently attend
- Your resume
- Essay- No more than two (2) pages double-spaced, your essay should describe what you hope to study/currently studying in college, what career you hope to pursue, **and/or** why a college education is important to you.

You must submit your completed application no later than **April 16, 2018**. To ensure that you will be considered for a Delegate Scholarship, you must also file the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) by the Maryland deadline of March 1, 2018.

Current High School Seniors:

All District 39 high school students are eligible for the Delegate Scholarship. Those students attending the following high schools in District 39 are encouraged to apply through their respective guidance counselors:

- Gaithersburg High School
- Magruder High School
- North West High School
- Quince Orchard High School
- Seneca Valley High School
- Watkins Mill High School
- Clarksburg High School

High school students offered the Delegate Scholarship must attend a Maryland public university or college, including community colleges, in order to receive the scholarship.

Current College Students:

Current college students from District 39 are eligible to apply for the Delegate Scholarship if they are attending a Maryland public university or college. Both full- and part-time students are eligible to apply, as well as transfer students. Full-time undergraduate students must maintain 12 credits or more per semester, while part-time undergraduate students must maintain 6-11 credits. Full-time graduate students must maintain 9 or more credits per semester, while part-time graduate students must maintain 6-8 credits per semester.

Out-of-State Programs

You may only use this scholarship at an out-of-state school if your major is not available at a Maryland school. The Office of Financial Aid must identify your major as "unique." To be considered for Unique Major Status, contact the Maryland Higher Education Commission (www.mhec.state.md.us) for the requirements.

The Delegate Scholarship is for a single academic year.
